

## Canberra International Film festival is pleased to present a series of six Workshops which have now been added to the Festival program

**Saturday 28 October at 11am** (NFSA Theatrette): **Steve Jodrell**, director of SHAME – discussing his 30 year career directing drama for television in Australia. Steve Jodrell will be in conversation with NFSA staff member, writer and film historian, **Cris Kennedy**.

**Saturday 28 October at 1.30pm** (NFSA Front Room): **Michael Brindley**, co-screenwriter of SHAME – discussing his career as a writer in the film industry and his advice for aspiring screenwriters. Michael Brindley will be in conversation with **Sarah Mason**, film producer, writer and Director of the ACT Writers Centre.

**Saturday 28 October at 1.30** (NFSA Theatrette): Panel discussion on "Women In leadership: Women in the Film Industry" with film director, **Gaylene Preston** (MY YEAR WITH HELEN), producer-director **Pat Fiske** (OYSTER and ROCKING THE FOUNDATIONS), and actor, **Simone Buchanan** (SHAME). Facilitator for the discussion will be **Virginia Haussegger**, **AM**.

**Sunday 29 October at 11am** (NFSA Theatrette): **Jan Muller,** the new Director of the NFSA, just arrived from the Netherlands – discussing new directions in archiving and what filmmakers need to know. Jan Muller will be in conversation with producer, publisher and film enthusiast, **Glenys Rowe.** 

**Saturday 4 November at 11am** (NFSA Theatrette): **Chris Fujiwara,** internationally renowned film historian and film programmer, author of a seminal study of the work of Jacques Tourneur, and more recently of a study of the films of Jerry Lewis. Chris Fujiwara will be in conversation with CIFF Director, **Andrew Pike.** 

**Sunday 5 November at 11am** (Arc Cinema): an illustrated presentation about the life, career and work of **Len Lye**, the New Zealand animator and kinetic sculptor. With film historian and Len Lye biographer, **Prof Roger Horrocks**, and film historian and archivist, **Sarah Davy**. Facilitator for the program will be **Dr Ray Edmondson**, President of the Friends of the NFSA.
